REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 1999-2001 23 24 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and 25 26 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - STATE. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - State for the 1997-99 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. 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SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Cash for the 1997-99 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Thirty one (31) thirty six (36) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

SECTION 7. EXTRA HELP - DIGITAL SATELLITE NETWORK - FEDERAL. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Digital Satellite Network - Federal for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish upon request for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division a special appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. When the Department of Education - Educational Television Division wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses appropriation to the promotional items line, the AETN Commission shall approve the request and forward it to

the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing. 1 2 3 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 5 LANGUAGE - CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the construction of a joint AETN/UCA complex, the Department of Education, Educational Television 6 7 Division shall establish and maintain for the 1999-2001 biennium a pool of 8 fifteen (15) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated herein for 9 such purposes. These positions are to be used by the Department of Education-10 Educational Television Division in the event that the number and level of 11 positions available to address the needs emerging from the construction of this new facility and the opportunity it presents to expand programming 12 13 exceeds the classified positions regularly authorized for the Department of 14 Education - Educational Television Division by the Legislature. 15 16 (b) The Department of Education - Educational Television Division shall 17 provide justification to the Department of Finance and Administration's Office 18 of Personnel Management (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this 19 position pool. No classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time 20 as specific positions are requested and justified by the Department of Education- Educational Television Division, recommended by OPM and approved by 21 22 the Arkansas Legislative Council. The Department of Education- Educational 23 Television Division may transfer positions and appropriations from this pool 24 to any appropriation/pay schedule the agency currently maintains or any 25 appropriation/pay schedule the agency receives during the 1999-2001 biennium. 26 [c] Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is 27 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 28 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the 29 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has 30 determined that Department of Education - Educational Television Division could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that 31 32 agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing growth pools in 33 subsection (a) of this section and since the General Assembly has granted the 34 agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and 35 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of 36 the growth pool by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the

utilization of the growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the 1 2 Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. If the 3 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 4 5 SECTION 10. CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated to the 6 7 Department of Education - Educational Television Division to be payable from the Department of Education - Educational Television Division's accounts for 8 9 any program, as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for use in responding to emerging needs resulting from the construction of the 10 AETN/UCA Complex, the following: 11 12 13 ITFM FISCAL YEARS 14 1999-00 NO. 2000-01 <u>\$1, 321, 431</u> 15 (01) Contingency \$1, 318, 703 16 17 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 18 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 20 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary 21 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures 22 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 23 24 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 25 with in disbursement of said funds. 26 27 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 33

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36 SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

1	nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

4	SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
5	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
6	not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
7	effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
8	provisions of this act are declared to be severable except for that provided
9	in Section 9 (c) herein.
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11	SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
12	this act are hereby repealed.
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14	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
15	Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
16	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
17	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
18	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
19	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
20	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
21	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
22	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
23	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
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
