There 4 is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - General Education Division - Federal Elementary and Secondary Education for the 1999-2001 5 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to 6 7 be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such 8 purposes: four (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of 9 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate 10 11 classification. 12 SECTION 21. The funds and appropriation authorized from the 20 Department of Education Public School Fund Account for Community-Based Pilot 21 Grants, shall be distributed for community based pilot program grants and the 22 coordination of existing state, federal and local programs that are directed 23 toward solving problems of children and their families. The Director of the Department of Human Services, the State board of Health and its designee, the 24 25 State board of Education and its designee and appropriate local officials shall report, cooperate, and coordinate their efforts with the Office of 26 27 Governor designee, including the reassigning of its employees and the redirection of funds, to assist the efforts of the community based pilot 28 29 programs directed toward solving problems of children and their families and each shall designate one of their employees located in the grantee's location 30 31 as being the person responsible for ligison between their employer and the 32 coordinator to programs which are directed toward meeting the needs of at-risk children in order to improve their academic achievement and to improve their 33 chances of success in public school. 3 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 ARKANSAS/STRIVE PROGRAM TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 5 transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of \$100,000 6 7 \$200,000 during the 1997-98 each fiscal year, of the biennium and the sum of \$200,000 during the 1998-99 fiscal year from the Department of Education 8 9 Public School Fund Account to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, 10 specifically to provide funding for the Arkansas/STRIVE Program. Due to pending public school finance litigation, before any rules and regulations pursuant to the implementation of Amendment 74 to the Arkansas Constitution are reviewed by the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and adopted by the Department of Education, such proposed rules and regulations shall be reviewed by the Litigation Reports Oversight Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council.

23 SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 24 25 ASSESSMENT/END OF LEVEL TESTING. Of the total amount appropriated for Assessment/End-of-Level Testing for each fiscal year of the 1997-99 1999-2001 26 27 biennium, up to \$500,000 may be authorized by the Director of Education, 28 General Division, to be used to provide staff development training for 29 educational cooperatives, school districts, and for Department of Education 30 staff on such content areas as test interpretation, goal setting, educational 31 plan development, curriculum development, instructional strategies, classroom 32 management and for evaluation procedures.

34 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FUND BALANCE CARRYFORWARD. Notwithstanding 35 any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund balances or any law to the 36 contrary, any funds which remain in the Department of Education Fund Account

at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the Department of Education Fund
Account and made available to fund appropriation authorized by law and made
payable from the Department of Education Fund Account for the following fiscal
year.

SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. LOAN/TRANSFER REPAYMENT. Notwi thstanding 6 7 the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated 19-5-501 et seq., or any law to the contrary, up to \$2,000,000 received by the Public School Fund from the Budget 8 9 Stabilization Trust Fund either by loan or transfer during the 1996-97 fiscal year, shall be repaid from time to time by transfer by the State Treasurer 10 11 from either the Public School Support Fund or the Public School Fund, or its 12 appropriate fund account, solely from revenues generated by the income tax 13 surcharge levied by Arkansas Code Annotated 6-20-312(c) after the provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated 19-6-481(b) have been achieved. 14

16 SECTION 32. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 17 18 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 19 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary 20 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of 21 22 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 23 24 with in disbursement of said funds.

25

SECTION 33. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 26 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 31 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 33 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34

35 SECTION 34. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 36 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 35. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. SECTION 36. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed. SECTION 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
