32 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby authorized, for the Forest 33 Echoes Technical Institute - Cash for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following 34 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 35 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty five 36 (25) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to

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1 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or 2 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification. 3 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 4 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring 6 7 of the Technical Institutes, Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall establish 8 and maintain for the 1999-2001 biennium a pool of three (3) unclassified 9 positions and two (2) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated 10 for Forest Echoes Technical Institute. These positions are to be used by Forest Echoes Technical Institute in the event that the number and level of 11 12 positions available to address the needs emerging from business and industry 13 driven program expansions exceeds the number of positions regularly authorized 14 for Forest Echoes Technical Institute. 15 16 (b) Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall provide justification to the 17 Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management 18 (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No 19 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested and justified by Forest Echoes Technical Institute, 20 recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. Forest Echoes 21 22 Technical Institute may transfer positions from this pool to any pay schedule 23 the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency receives during 24 the 1999-2001 biennium. 25 26 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is 27 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 28 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the 29 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has 30 determined that Forest Echoes Technical Institute could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is 31 32 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this section 33 and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the 34 growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 35 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by requiring 36 prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the growth

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1	pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is
2	not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the
3	Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this

15	SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
16	this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
17	available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions

It is the intent of the General Assembly 26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 30 31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 32 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 36 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2	SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
3	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
4	not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
5	effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
6	provisions of this act are declared to be severable except that provided in
7	Section 6 (c) herein.
8	
9	SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
10	this act are hereby repealed.

12	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
13	Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
14	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
15	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18	<u>date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the</u>
19	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22	<u>safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.</u>
