All funds that become available for Adult Education shall first be distributed to those administrative units determined to be operating efficient and effective adult education programs, under criteria established by the State Board of Vocational Education Workforce Education and Career Opportunities and shall be at the same level as expended by each unit in the most recent fiscal year for which there is complete data base level year (hereafter referred to as base

funding). The criteria shall include the relative efficiency of 1 2 administration of the program in the counties served. For the purposes of 3 this Section, the term "literacy rate" shall be determined by the number of 4 adults completing less than the twelfth grade as reported by the most recent decennial federal census. Except for special projects, 50% of the remaining 5 monies shall be distributed based upon the literacy rate per county and 50% 6 7 shall be distributed on the basis of the performance outcomes for the previous year, as established by the State Board of Vocational Workforce Education and 8 9 Career Opportunities. Of the funds distributed based on literacy rate, no administrative unit shall receive funds for any county served above that 10 11 county's literacy rate cap except for base funds received by efficient and 12 effective units. Local administrative costs shall not exceed 10% of the total 13 allocation. Unallocated funds will be redistributed based upon need as determined by the State Board of Vocational Workforce Education and Career 14 15 Opportiunities. Further, the State Board of Vocational Workforce Education 16 and Career Opportunities shall give first consideration and priority in the distribution of monies set aside for special projects to counties receiving 17 18 less funding by the formula.

In the event that any postsecondary vocational institution merges with a contiguous community college, the director of the vocational institute shall become eligible for a \$10,000 increase in annual salary and the assistant director shall become eligible for a \$5,000 increase in annual salary following such a merger.

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SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. VOCATIONAL CENTER. In the event a secondary vocational center is established in the North East Arkansas Educational Cooperative Region, the center shall be funded in the same manner as all other vocational centers on an average daily membership basis, as authorized by law, and operated by the Model Vocational-Technical Education Resource Center.

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SECTION 32. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 42. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 43. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 44. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.

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
