Arkansas Code 5-73-120 is amended to read as follows: 20 "5-73-120. Carrying a weapon. (a) A person commits the offense of carrying a weapon if he possesses a 21 22 handgun, knife, or club on or about his person, in a vehicle occupied by him, or otherwise readily available for use with a purpose to employ it as a weapon 23 24 against a person. Mere possession of a weapon is not an offense or violation of this act; however, a person commits the offense of carrying a weapon if 25 that person takes any overt action to use a handgun, knife or club as a weapon 26 27 against a person without just cause. (b) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires: 28 29 (1) 'Handgun' means any firearm with a barrel length of less than twelve inches (12") that is designed, made, or adapted to be fired with one (1) hand; 30 31 (2) 'Knife' means any bladed hand instrument that is capable of inflicting serious physical injury or death by cutting or stabbing. It 32 includes a dirk, sword or spear in a cane, razor, ice pick, and a throwing 33 star, switchblade, and butterfly knife; and 34 35 (3) 'Club' means any instrument that is specially designed, made, or adapted for the purpose of inflicting serious physical injury or death by 36

- 2 (c) It is a defense to a prosecution under this section that at the time
- 3 of the act of carrying:
- 4 (1) The person is in his own dwelling, place of business, or on property
- 5 in which he has a possessory or proprietary interest; or
- 6 (2) The person is a law enforcement officer, prison guard, or member of
- 7 the armed forces, acting in the course and scope of his official duties; or
- 8 (3) The person is assisting a law enforcement officer, prison quard, or
- 9 member of the armed forces acting in the course and scope of official duties
- 10 pursuant to the direction or request of the law enforcement officer, prison
- 11 quard, or member of the armed forces; or
- 12 (4) The person is carrying a weapon when upon a journey; or
- 13 (5) The person is a licensed security guard acting in the course and
- 14 scope of his duties; or
- 15 (6) The person is hunting game with a handgun which may be hunted with a
- 16 handgun under rules and regulations of the Arkansas State Game and Fish

- 22 (d)(1) Any person who carries a weapon into an establishment that sells
- 23 alcoholic beverages shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a
- 24 fine of not more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or
- 25 imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, or both.
- 26 (2) Otherwise, carrying a weapon is a Class A misdemeanor."
