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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
28 State University for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of
29 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
32 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
33 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
34 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
35 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
36 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the *General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts*, for personal services and maintenance and general operations of the Institute for the Study of the Prevention and Intervention of Violence for Schools in Rural Communities of the Arkansas State University for each fiscal year of the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the sum of\$618,855.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
2 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
9 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
10 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
11 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
12 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
15 this act are hereby repealed.

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17 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
18 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
19 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
20 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
