22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-701 is amended to read as follows:

25	(a) As soon as the returns from all the precincts are received, but in
	no event later than the third calendar day after the election, the county
	coard of election commissioners, from the certificates and ballots received
	from the several precincts, shall proceed to ascertain <u>,</u> and declare <u>and</u>
	<u>certify</u> the result of the election <u>to the Secretary of State</u> , unless the
	number of absentee ballots is sufficient to affect the election, in which case the county board of election commissioners shall declare results of the
	election no earlier later than the tenth calendar day after the election. The

	fourteen (14) calendar days if the number of absentee ballots is sufficient to
	affect the election, shall deliver a certificate of election to any person

If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
