(d)(1) The fee for a list, on computer disk or tape, of one (1) to five thousand (5,000) registered voters shall may be up to ten dollars (\$10.00). (2) The fee for a list, on computer disk or tape, of five thousand and one (5,001) to twenty-five thousand (25,000) registered voters shall may be up to twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). (3) The fee for a list, on computer disk or tape, of more than twenty-five thousand (25,000) registered voters shall may be up to fifty dollars (\$50.00)." SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
