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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-111-515 (b)(1)(B) is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "(B) Seventy-five percent (75%) of the proceeds shall be ~~deposited with~~
25 ~~the Treasurer of State as special revenues and credited to an institution of~~
26 ~~higher education fund in the county in which the dog racing track is located~~
27 remitted directly to Mid-South Community College and shall be used by the
28 college for facilities, programming, and personnel in the support of economic
29 development in the area. Such funds shall be considered local taxes for the
30 purposes of § 6-61-601. "
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32 SECTION 2. In lieu of the procedures under Arkansas Code 23-111-505
33 (b), the pari-mutual tax revenue derived from Arkansas Code 23-111-505 (a)
34 shall be remitted directly to Mid-South Community College and shall be used by
35 the college for facilities, programming, and personnel in the support of
36 economic development in the area. The funds shall be considered local taxes

1 for the purposes of § 6-61-601.

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3 SECTION 3. The balance of the Indigent Patient's fund on the effective
4 date of this act shall be transferred by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
5 to the Mid-South Community College Fund and shall notify the State treasurer
6 and State Auditor of such transfer.

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8 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.
