Such funds shall be considered local taxes for the 30 purposes of § 6-61-601." 31 SECTION 2. 3	SECTION 3. The balance of the Indigent Patient's fund on the effective
4	date of this act shall be transferred by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
5	to the Mid-South Community College Fund and shall notify the State treasurer
6	and State Auditor of such transfer.

8	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12	SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
