| 4  | demand technical training programs which shall be forgiven if the recipient          |  |
| 5  | works in a high demand technical occupation in Arkansas and satisfies other          |  |
| 6  | requirements as set out in this act.   |  |

| 8  | SECTION 3. Administration.   |  |
| 9  | The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities through              |  |
| 10 | the Department of Workforce Education shall administer the Arkansas Technical        |  |
| 11 | Careers Student Loan Forgiveness Program and shall have the following                |  |
| 12 | authority with respect to the program:   |  |
| 13 | (1) To adopt rules and regulations for the administration of the                     |  |
| 14 | program consistent with the provisions of this act;                                  |  |
| 15 | (2) To prepare application forms or such other forms as the State                    |  |
| 16 | Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities shall deem necessary to        |  |
| 17 | properly administer and carry out the purpose of this subchapter;                    |  |
| 18 | (3) To establish and consult with an advisory panel that is                          |  |
| 19 | representative of agencies and entities involved in the economic development         |  |
| 20 | of Arkansas, including business and industry;  |  |
| 21 | (4) To contract with an experienced third party, the Arkansas                        |  |
| 22 | Student Loan Authority or another qualified agency for the administration of         |  |
| 23 | this loan forgiveness program.   |  |

| 25 | SECTION 4. <u>Institutional eligibility.</u>   |  |
| 26 | The institution to be attended under the loan forgiveness program must be            |  |
| 27 | approved by the State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities or       |  |
| 28 | the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board to offer training in the            |  |
| 29 | technical field chosen by the applicant.   |  |

| 31 | SECTION 5. <u>Educational Program Approval and Priorities.</u>                       |  |
| 32 | (a) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities                  |  |
| 33 | shall consider comments and suggestions from the Department of Higher                |  |
| 34 | Education, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the Arkansas            |  |
| 35 | Economic Development Commission, the Employment Security Department, the State       |  |
| 36 | Chamber of Commerce, and other appropriate entities to annually develop and          |  |

| 3  | (b) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities may        |
| 4  | consider the state, regional, and local area priorities when determining the   |
| 5  | technical programs that are approved; however, for the 1999-2000 fiscal year,  |
| 6  | only state priorities shall be considered.                                     |
| 7  | (c) Beginning in the 2000-2001 fiscal year, the State Board of                 |
| 8  | Workforce Education and Career Opportunities may solicit proposals or requests |
| 9  | from the state's postsecondary institutions, chambers of commerce, business    |
| 10 | and industry, and other appropriate local entities for regional and local      |
| 11 | priorities when determining the approved technical programs for this program.  |

| 13 | SECTION 6. Student eligibility - Initial Certification of Eligibility.         |
| 14 | (a) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities            |
| 15 | shall certify eligibility for people who meet the following conditions:        |
| 16 | (1) Are residents of the State of Arkansas and citizens of the                 |
| 17 | United States or permanent resident aliens;                                    |
| 18 | (2) Are admitted to an approved program resulting in a diploma,                |
| 19 | certificate or degree in a high demand technical field;                        |
| 20 | (3) Have a grade point average as required in the rules and                    |
| 21 | regulations for administration of this loan forgiveness program for the        |
| 22 | specified technical field; and   |
| 23 | (4) Indicate an intention to work in Arkansas in the high demand               |
| 24 | technical field for which they receive the training.                           |
| 25 | (b) Students must apply for the Loan forgiveness program, and be               |
| 26 | selected by a process administered by the State Board of Workforce Education   |
| 27 | and Career Opportunities.  |

| 29 | SECTION 7. Amount of Loan forgiveness.   |
| 30 | (a) The yearly amount for each student's loan forgiveness shall                |
| 31 | not exceed the maximum yearly amount allowed under the Arkansas Academic       |
| 32 | Challenge Scholarship program.   |
| 33 | (b) Eligible students may participate in the loan forgiveness                  |
| 34 | program for a maximum of four (4) years, or its equivalent, as determined by   |
| 35 | rules and regulations.   |
| 36 | <u>(c) The State Board shall establish through rules and</u>                   |

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| 1  | regulations, with input from the Department of Higher Education and other      |
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| 2  | appropriate entities, loan forgiveness amounts for approved technical          |
| 3  | education programs for students enrolled on a less than full-time basis.       |

| 5  | SECTION 8. Repayment of Loans - Failure to repay.                              |
| 6  | (a) After graduation from the approved technical program, loan                 |
| 7  | recipients who work for one year on a full-time basis in Arkansas in the high  |
| 8  | demand technical field for which the educational program prepared them shall   |
| 9  | upon annual certification by their employer, be forgiven one (1) year of the   |
| 10 | eligible loan amount or its equivalent for persons who enrolled in an          |
| 11 | educational program on a less than regular full-time basis. Each succeeding    |
| 12 | year of loan forgiveness is contingent upon one additional year of certified   |
| 13 | full-time employment in Arkansas in the technical field.                       |
| 14 | (b) Loan recipients who do not graduate from the program or who do not         |
| 15 | work full-time in the high demand technical field in the state of Arkansas for |
| 16 | which they received training shall repay the loan in accordance with the loan  |
| 17 | recipient's agreement with the lending authority.                              |

| 19 | SECTION 9. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature        |
| 20 | are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code    |
| 21 | Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.                    |

| 23 | SECTION 10. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to         |
| 24 | any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect   |
| 25 | other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  |
| 26 | the invalid provision or application, and the this end the provisions of this  |
| 27 | act are declared to be severable.  |

| 29 | SECTION 11. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are           |
| 30 | hereby repealed.   |

| 32 | SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the         |
| 33 | Eighty-second General Assembly that there is a continuing and pressing need    |
| 34 | for skilled technical workers by business and industry in Arkansas which makes |
| 35 | it necessary to establish this Arkansas Technical Careers Student Loan         |

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| I        | that will prepare them for such work. Therefore, an emergency is declared to   |
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| 2        | exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the     |
| 3        | public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its      |
| 4        | approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the    |
| 5        | Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time    |
| 6        | during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the      |
| 7        | Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the |
| 8        | last house overrides the veto.   |
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
