21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. (a) The Arkansas Code Revision Commission is hereby
24 instructed to delete "[As enacted by Acts 1997, No. 343]" from the catchline
25 of Arkansas Code 7-7-204 as enacted by Act 343 of 1997.

26 (b) The Arkansas Code Revision Commission is hereby instructed to
27 delete "7-7-204." and "[As enacted by Acts 1997, No. 886]" from the catchline
28 of Arkansas Code 7-7-204 as enacted by Act 886 of 1997 and to properly
29 renumber the section.

30 (c) Since the catchline for 7-7-301 is identical to 7-7-204 as enacted
31 by Act 886 of 1997 and incorrect, the Code Revision Commission is instructed
32 to change the catchline of 7-7-301 to read "7-7-301. Party pledges and party
33 filing fees."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
