20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Amendment 51, Section 9 of the Arkansas Constitution is
23 amended by adding the following new subsection to be appropriately lettered by
24 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission:

25 "If an election law deadline occurs on a Saturday, Sunday or legal
26 holiday, the deadline shall be the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or
27 legal holiday."

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
