9 WITH THE PURCHASE OF LAND, CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING
10 A WORKFORCE EDUCATION CENTER IN CLARK COUNTY FOR THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE EDUCATION FOR THE BIENNIAL
12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2001; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - WORKFORCE EDUCATION CENTER. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Department of Workforce Education, to be payable from
25 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
26 following:

27 (A) For costs associated with the purchase of land, constructing and
28 equipping a Workforce Education Center in Clark County, the sum of
29 ..\$450,000.
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31 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
34 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal



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1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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18 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
19 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
20 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
21 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
22 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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24 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
25 this act are hereby repealed.

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27 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
28 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
29 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
30 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to
31 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
32 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
33 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work
34 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
35 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
36 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
2 July 1, 1999.
