## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLI SH THE ARKANSAS I NSTI TUTI ON FOR ADVOCACY FOR THE DEAF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

"AN ACT TO ESTABLI SH THE ARKANSAS I NSTI TUTI ON FOR ADVOCACY FOR THE DEAF."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. (a) There is created the Arkansas I nstitution for Advocacy for the Deaf. The institution shall be an institution of learning to train i ndi vi dual s to become advocates for the deaf and to provi de the i nf ormati on to the publ ic concerning the needs and rights of deaf citizens.
(b) The i nstitution may provi de educational servi ces through a cooper ative vent ure with one (1) or more institutions of hi gher education.
(c) The educational program of the institution shall not dupl icate any social, rehabilitative, or educational programs for the deaf that are in existence in the state on the effective date of this act.

SECTI ON 2. (a) There is created the Arkansas Board for the Institution for Advocacy for the Deaf.
(b) (1) The members of the board shall be appoi nt ed by the Gover nor as foll ows:
(A) Two (2) members shall be persons certified or degreed in the education of children who are deaf;
(B) One (1) member shall be a person who is legally deaf; (C) One (1) member shal l be the parent of a l egally deaf
child; and
(D) One (1) member shal l be appoi nted from the gener al publ ic.
(2) Appoi nt ments shall be made so that no more than two (2) menbers of the board shall resi de in the same congressional di strict.
(3) The racial make-up of the board should reflect the racial popul ation of the state as accurately as possi ble.
(c) The members of the board shall serve for terms of five (5) years. The initial appointees shall determine their terns by lot so that the term of one (1) member shall expi re each year.
(d) The nembers of the board shall annually el ect a chairperson.
(e) Meetings of the board shall be hel d during evening hours or on Sat urdays. At least twenty (20) mi nutes shall be reserved at the end of each board meeting for members of the public to address the board.
(f) Each member of the board may recei ve expense rei mbursement in accordance with 25-16-902.

SECTI ON 3. Arkansas Board for the Institution for Advocacy for the Deaf may:
(1) Enter into cooper ative vent ures with one (1) or more institutions of hi gher educati on for the provision of facilities, equi prent, and staff necessary for the institution; and
(2) Accept donations, gifts, and contributions in money, services, materials, or ot herwise from any source and use or expend such moneys, services, materials, or other contributions in carrying on its oper ations, and accept appropriations fromthe state upon such terms and conditions as may be imposed by law to be used in the further ance of this act.

SECTI ON 4. All provisions of this act of a gener al and permant nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 5. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunstance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the act which can be given effect wi thout
the i nval id provi si on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 6. All I aws and parts of I aws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
