Arkansas Code 14-42-109(a) is amended to read as follows: 21 22 "(a)(1)(A) If the mayor or police judge, member of the city council, or any other elective officer of any city of the first class or second class or 23 incorporated town in this state shall wilfully willfully and knowingly fail, 24 refuse, or neglect to execute, or cause to be executed, any of the duties, 25 laws or ordinances within their jurisdiction, or cease to attend and discharge 26 the duties of their office for a period of three (3) months, except when 27 prevented by an extended illness, they shall be deemed guilty of nonfeasance 28 29 malfeasance in office. (B)(i) It shall be the duty of the circuit court of any 30 31 county within which any officer may be commissioned and acting, upon indictment charging any such officer with nonfeasance malfeasance in office, 32 to hear and determine the charges. 33 (ii) If, upon hearing, the charges are proved to be 34 true, the court shall enter a judgment of record removing the quilty officer 35 36 from office.

2	ordinance, for the removal of any appointive officer upon a majority vote of
3	the council."

5	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 14-43-501(A)(2) is amended by adding a new
6	subdivision to be appropriately lettered by the Arkansas Code Revision
7	Commi ssi on:
8	"They shall set monetary penalties, not to exceed one (1) month's
9	salary, to be imposed against members failing to attend meetings of the city
10	council for a period of three (3) months, except when the member is prevented
11	from attending the meetings due to an extended illness."
12	
13	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
16	
17	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21	act are declared to be severable.
22	
23	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24	hereby repeal ed.
