27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - COLLEGE OF INFORMATION SCIENCES AND SYSTEMS
30 ENGINEERING. There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas at
31 Little Rock - College of Information Sciences and Systems Engineering for the
32 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
33 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
34 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
35 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
36 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt

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1 from the provisions of said Uni form Cl assi fi ca ti on and Com pen sa ti on Act. All
 2 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
 3 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
 4 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

12 In the event that there are not sufficient funds to make the full
 13 distributions as set out in this section, each institution's share of the
 14 amount available to be distributed shall be the institution's proportionate
 15 part of the total of all distributions authorized herein.

16

17 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 19 TRANSFER. FUNDING TRANSFER. On July 1, 1999, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 20 State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of
 21 \$2,000,000 from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the University of
 22 Arkansas at Little Rock Fund and on July 1, 2000 the sum of \$4,000,000 from
 23 the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to the University of Arkansas at Little
 24 Rock Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein for the
 25 operations of the College of Information Sciences and Systems Engineering.

26

27 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 28 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 29 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 30 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 31 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 32 Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their
 33 successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
 34 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as
 35 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
 36 funds.

1
 2 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 3 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 4 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 5 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 6 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 8 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 9 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10
 11 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 12 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 13 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

14
 15 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
 16 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 17 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 18 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 19 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

20
 21 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 22 this act are hereby repealed.

23
 24 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 25 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
 26 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
 27 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
 31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
