21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Co	ode 9-9-102 (b) is amen	ded to read as follows:
22	"9-9-102. Religious preference - Removal of barriers to interethnic		
23	adoption - Preference to relative caregivers for a child in foster care.		
24	(a) In all custodial placements by the Department of Human Services in		
25	foster care or investigations conducted by the Department of Human Services		
26	pursuant to court order under	⁻ § 9-9-212, preferenti	al consideration shall be
27	given to an adult relative over a nonrelated caregiver provided that the		
28	relative caregiver meets all relevant child protection standards and it is in		
29	the child's best interest to	be placed with the rela	ative caregiver.
30	(b) The Department of	Human Services and any	other agency or entity
31	which receives federal assist	tance and is involved i	n adoption or foster care
32	placement shall not discriminate on the basis of the race, color, <u>sexual</u>		
33	orientation, or national origin of the adoptive or foster parent or the child		
34	involved nor delay the placement of a child on the basis of race, color,

1	placing the child in a foster home or an adoptive home of the same or a		
2	similar religious background to that of the genetic parent or parents, the		
3	court shall place the child with a family that meets the genetic parent's		
4	religious preference, or if a family is not available, to a family of a		
5	different religious background which is knowledgeable and appreciative of the		
6	child's religious background.		
7	(d) The court shall not deny a petition for adoption on the basis of		
8	race, color, <u>sexual orientation,</u> or national origin of the adoptive parent or		
9	the child involved.

11	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
12	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
13	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		
14			
15	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
16	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
17	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
18	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
19	act are declared to be severable.

21	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
22	hereby repealed.
