20 21	SECTION 1. Section 3 of uncodified Act 1288 of 1993, as amended by	
22	uncodified Act 596 of 1995, as amended by uncodified Act 112 of 1997 is	
23	amended to read as follows:	
24	"Section 3. (a) The Arkansas Pygmalion Commission on Nontraditional	ı
 25	Education shall be composed of eighteen (18) sixteen (16) members who are	
26	currently serving as members of the board and who were to be appointed in	the
27	manner and to represent various interests as follows:	
28	(1) One (1) member representing classroom teachers to be	
29	recommended by the Arkansas Education Association and appointed by the	
30	Governor;	
31	(2) One (1) member representing school district superintenden	ts
32	to be recommended by the Arkansas Association of Education Administrators a	and
33	appointed by the Governor;	
34	(3) One (1) member representing local school boards to be	
35	recommended by the Arkansas School Boards Association and appointed by the	
36	Governor;	

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1	(4) Two (2) members representing school principals with
2	alternative education experience to be recommended by the Arkansas Association
3	of Education Administrators and appointed by the Governor;
4	(5) One (1) member representing the Department of Health and
5	appointed by the Governor;
6	(6) One (1) member representing the Department of Human Services
7	and appointed by the Governor;
8	(7) One (1) member representing the General Education Division of
9	the Department of Education and appointed by the Governor;
10	(8) One (1) member representing the Vocational and Technical
11	Education Division of the Department of Education Department of Workforce
12	Education and Career Opportunities and appointed by the Governor;
13	(9) One (1) member representing the Department of Higher
14	Education and appointed by the Governor;
15	(10) One (1) member of the House of Representatives Interim
16	Committee on Education and the Joint Interim Committee on Education or a House
17	member of the Joint Committee on Children and Youth to be appointed by the
18	Speaker of the House;
19	(11) One (1) member of the Senate Interim Committee on Education
20	and the Joint Interim Committee on Education or a Senate member of the Joint
21	Committee on Children and Youth to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore
22	of the Senate;
23	(12) (10) One (1) member representing the judicial system to be
24	appointed by the Governor;
25	(13) (11) One (1) member representing students with learning
26	disabilities or Attention Deficit Disorder to be appointed by the Governor;
27	(14) (12) Two (2) members representing physicians and
28	psychologists who specialize in treating children and adolescents to be
29	recommended by the Chief of Staff of Arkansas Children's Hospital and
30	appointed by the Governor;
31	(15) (13) One (1) member representing parents to be recommended by
32	the Arkansas Congress of Parents and Teachers Association and appointed by the
33	Governor; and
34	(16) (14) One (1) member at-large to be appointed by the Governor.
35	(b) Any vacancies shall be filled in accordance with the original
36	appointment.

1	(b) (c) The commission shall expire on June 30, 1999 June 30, 2003,
2	unless the commission is continued by further act of the Arkansas General
3	Assembly."
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5	SECTION 2. Section 6(a) of uncodified Act 1288 of 1993, as amended by
6	uncodified Act 112 of 1997 is amended to read as follows:
7	"(a) Members of the Arkansas Pygmalion Commission on Nontraditional
8	Education shall serve without pay, but the commission may, if sufficient funds
9	are available, reimburse non-legislative and non-state employee members for
10	actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
11	Legislative members of the commission shall receive, in lieu of reimbursement
12	for expenses, the same per diem rate as members of the General Assembly
13	attending meetings of the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education and
14	shall be paid from funds appropriated for that purpose. Expenses of state
15	employees serving on the commission shall be reimbursed from funds
16	appropriated to that agency for such purposes."
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18	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
19	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
20	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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22	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
23	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
24	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
25	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
26	act are declared to be severable.
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28	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
29	hereby repealed.
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
