" 20 21 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 23 24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-90-712 is amended to read as follows: "16-90-712. Conditions for reparations - Changes in awards. 25 (a) Reparations shall not be awarded: 26 (1) Unless the claim has been filed with the board within one (1) 27 year after the injury or death upon which the claim is based unless the board 28 29 shall find good cause for the failure to file a timely claim; (2) To a claimant who was the offender or an accomplice of the 30 31 offender: (3) To another person if the award would unjustly benefit the 32 offender or accomplice; 33 (4) To a victim who is injured or killed while confined in state, 34 35 county, or municipal jail, prison, or other correctional facility as a result of conviction of any crime; 36

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1 (5) To any claimant who has been convicted of a felony involving 2 criminally injurious conduct;

- (6) Unless the criminally injurious conduct resulting in injury or death was reported to a <u>law enforcement officer</u> the proper authorities within seventy-two (72) hours after its occurrence or the board finds there was good cause for the failure to report within that time; or
- (7) If there are insufficient funds in the Crime Victims Reparations Revolving Fund. However, when sufficient funds become available, the awards which have not been paid shall be paid in chronological order, with the oldest paid first, unless the board shall find that compelling circumstances support a payment out of chronological order. Any award hereunder is specifically not a claim against the state if it cannot be paid due to a lack of funds in the Crime Victims Reparations Revolving Fund.
- (b) Reparations otherwise payable to a claimant shall be diminished to the extent:
- That the economic loss is recouped from collateral sources;
  - (2) Of the degree of responsibility for the cause of the injury or death attributable to the victim as determined by the board.
  - (c) Upon finding that the claimant or victim has not fully cooperated with appropriate law enforcement agencies, the board may deny, withdraw, or reduce an award of reparations.
  - (d) On its own motion or on request of the claimant, the board may reconsider a decision granting or denying an award or determining its amount. An order on reconsideration of an award shall not require a refund of amounts previously paid unless the award was obtained by fraud. Reconsideration does not affect the finality of a board decision for the purpose of judicial review."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
