BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 5-65-111 (b) is amended to read as follows:
"(b) Any person who pleads guilty, nolo contendere, or is found guilty of vi ol ating §5-65-103 or any other equi val ent penal law of another state or foreign jurisdiction shall be imprisoned:
(1) For no less than seven (7) days and no more than one (1) year for the second of fense occurring within three (3) years of the first offense;
(3) (2) For at least one (1) year but no more than six (6) years for the fourth third or subsequent of fense occurring within three (3) five (5) years of the first offense and shall be guilty of a fel ony."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ his act of a gener al and permanent nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect wi thout
the i nvalid provisi on or appl i cation, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of I aws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
