Arkansas Code 5-65-111 (b) is amended to read as follows: "(b) Any person who pleads quilty, nolo contendere, or is found quilty 21 22 of violating § 5-65-103 or any other equivalent penal law of another state or foreign jurisdiction shall be imprisoned: 23 (1) For no less than seven (7) days and no more than one (1) year 24 for the second offense occurring within three (3) years of the first offense; 25 (3) (2) For at least one (1) year but no more than six (6) years 26 for the fourth third or subsequent offense occurring within three (3) five (5) 27 28 years of the first offense and shall be guilty of a felony." 29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 32 33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 36
