

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-71-214 is amended to read as follows:
22	"5-71-214. Obstructing a highway or other public passage.
23	(a) A person commits the offense of obstructing a highway or other
24	public passage if, having no legal privilege to do so and acting alone or with
25	other persons, he renders any highway or other public passage impassable to
26	pedestrian or vehicular traffic.
27	(b) It shall be a defense to a prosecution under this section that:
28	(1) The highway or other public passage was rendered impassable
29	solely because of a gathering of persons to hear the defendant speak or
30	otherwise communicate; <del>or</del>
31	(2) The defendant was a member of a gathering contemplated by
32	subdivision (1) of this subsection <u>-; or</u>
33	(3) The highway or public passage obstructed has not been
34	established as a city street, county road, or state or federal highway under
35	the laws of this state and no civil court has established a right of passage
36	by prescription for such highway or passage."



(c) Obstructing a highway or other public passage is a Class C misdemeanor. SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
