SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined SECTION 5. by the Eighty-second General Assembly that the Arkansas State Board of Physical Therapy requires the services of Extra Help personnel, and without the authorization of extra help personnel and the corresponding appropriation transfer authority, the Board will not be able to efficiently and effectively carry out its responsibilities. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on July 1, 1999.
