18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-42-104(a)(3) is amended to read as follows:

21 "(3) In addition to the annual resident basic and sportsman
22 hunting license fees authorized in this subsection, the commission, by
23 regulation, may provide that any resident of this state who is sixteen (16)
24 years of age or older be required, for the privilege of hunting migratory
25 birds in this state, to obtain a special permit and pay a special annual fee
26 not to exceed seven dollars (\$7.00) each, and, for the privilege of taking a
27 bonus deer in addition to the deer authorized with the basic hunting license
28 and the sportsman hunting license, to obtain a special permit and pay a
29 special fee not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) each, and, for the privilege of
30 hunting elk in this state, to obtain a special permit and pay a special annual
31 fee not to exceed thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) each."

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
