22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Every motor vehicle, "police car", or emergency vehicle
25 operated by any law enforcement agency or department on any public highway,
26 roadway, or street in this state which is used by that law enforcement agency
27 or department for highway and traffic control and the enforcement of the
28 highway and traffic laws of this state, shall be equipped with:

29 (1) the distinctive colors, markings and insignias of the law
30 enforcement agency it represents;

31 (2) an appropriate license plate; and

32 (3) a light bar across the top of the motor vehicle which contains an
33 oscillating, rotating or flashing light or device.

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
