9	SECTION 2. (a) The Department of Workforce Education and Career

13	Opportuni ti es;		
14	(2) Establish guidelines for accepting the surplus computers and		
15	<pre>computer equi pment;</pre>		
16	(3) Establish guidelines for repairing or refurbishing the		
17	surplus computers and computer equipment;		
18	(4) Establish the procedure for transferring title of the		
19	computers to public school districts for their use;		
20	(5) Promote the use of students in workforce education programs		
21	to refurbish the surplus computers and computer equipment; and		
22	(6) Ensure the proper administration of this program.		
23	(b) The Department of Information Systems and the Office of State		
24	<u>Purchasing of the Department of Finance and Administration shall cooperate</u>		
25	with the Department of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities in		
26	promulgating rules and regulations pertaining to the repairing or refurbishing		
27	of surplus computers and computer equipment.

29	SECTION 3. The Department of Workforce Education and Career		
30	Opportunities shall annually, by July 15, present a report to the Advance		
31	Communications and Information Technology Committee. The report shall		
32	<u>i ncl ude:</u>		
33	(1) The number of surplus computers donated to school districts;		
34	(2) The monies spent by the Department of Workforce Education and		
35	Career Opportunities in refurbishing the computers and computer equipment; and		
36	(3) Any other information requested of it by the Committee.

2	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
3	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
5	
6	SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10	act are declared to be severable.
11	
12	SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13	hereby repealed.
