## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-71-211
TO I NCREASE THE PENALTY FOR THREATENI NG A FI RE OR BOMBI NG. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 5-71-211 is amended to read as follows:
"5-71-211. Threatening a fire or bonbing.
(a) A person comits the offense of threatening a fire or bonbing if he purposely threatens damage or injury to the person or property of another by bombing, fire, or ot her means, in a manner likely to place another person in reasonable apprehension of physical injury to himelf or another or of damage to his property or to the property of another, or to create public al arm
(b) Threatening a fire or bombing is a Cl ass D fel ony if physical injury to a person results. Ot herwise, it is a Class A insdemeanor."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ hi $s$ act of a gener al and permanent nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annot ated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circunstance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect





ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the i nval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
