20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-16-903 is amended to read as follows:

23 "25-16-903. Stipend - Authorization for \$50.

24 Each of the following state boards may, by a majority vote of the total
25 membership of the board cast during its first regularly scheduled meeting of
26 each calendar year, authorize payment to its members of a stipend not to
27 exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) per meeting attended, and the board members
28 shall receive no other compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of
29 payments except as provided in § 25-16-902:

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
