Arkansas Code § 14-14-812 is amended to read as follows: "14-14-812. Cemetery access roads. 25 (a) A 'cemetery', as used in this section, means any burying place for 26 the dead, a burial plot, a graveyard, or any land, public or private, 27 28 dedicated and used for the interment of human remains which includes at least 29 six (6) grave markers. (b)(1) The county judges of the several county governments in Arkansas 30 31 shall be authorized to improve and maintain any roads across public or private lands used or to be used for access to a cemetery. 32 (2) The cemetery access roads shall be constructed to a standard 33 and nature to permit their use by automobiles. 34 35 (3) The cemetery access roads to cemeteries of ten (10) or more grave markers shall be constructed at least ten (10) feet wide over its entire 36

1	length from the nearest public road to permit their use by automobiles to
2	allow for ingress and egress by persons with disabilities.
3	(c) No access road shall be abandoned or closed to any cemetery without
4	a grant of a new easement by a property owner for a new road and entrance.
5	(d) This section shall not apply to any access road or cemetery located
6	on property which is being used or developed as an industrial site."

8	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
11	
12	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16	act are declared to be severable.

18	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19	hereby repeal ed.
