10 FOR A PURPLE HEART LICENSE PLATE FOR MOTORCYCLES; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-15-901 is amended to read as follows:

22 "27-15-901. Eligibility and issuance.

23 (a) Each Arkansas resident who, while serving in the United States  
24 armed forces, was awarded a Purple Heart medal and has received an honorable  
25 discharge from the United States armed forces or the unmarried surviving  
26 spouse of any such Purple Heart medal recipient is entitled to register one  
27 (1) automobile, as defined by § 27-14-601(a)(1), or one (1) Class One truck,  
28 as defined by § 27-14-601(a)(3)(A), or one (1) motorcycle and receive a free  
29 special permanent Purple Heart license plate.

30 (b)(1) The license plate shall be issued by the Department of Finance  
31 and Administration upon application containing certification by the United  
32 States Department of Defense of the applicant's award of the Purple Heart or  
33 if the applicant is an unmarried surviving spouse of a Purple Heart recipient  
34 upon application accompanied by certification by the United States Department  
35 of Defense that the deceased was a recipient of the Purple Heart medal and  
36 such proof as the Department of Finance and Administration may reasonably

1 require that the applicant is the unmarried surviving spouse of the Purple  
2 Heart recipient.

3 (2) Any person desiring this special plate for more than one (1)  
4 motor vehicle may receive extra plates and shall be charged two dollars  
5 (\$2.00) for each motor vehicle. "

6  
7 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
8 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
9 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10  
11 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
15 act are declared to be severable.

16  
17 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
18 hereby repealed.
