28	(a)(1) The Dir	ector of the Department of Finance (and Administration

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- (3) The director may revoke or suspend the license issued under the provisions of this subchapter of any person who refuses or neglects to comply with any provisions of this subchapter or any rule or regulation of the director prescribed under this subchapter.
- (b) Whenever any person fails to comply with any provision of this subchapter or any rule or regulation of the director promulgated thereunder, the director upon hearing, after giving the person ten (10) days' notice in writing specifying the time and place of the hearing and requiring him to show cause why his license should not be revoked, may revoke or suspend the license held by the person.
- (c) Any ruling, order, or decision of the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration Tobacco Control Board shall be subject to review, as provided by law, in any court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the person affected resides."

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 4-75-707(b) is amended to read as follows:
- "(b) All such licenses shall be issued by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration Tobacco Control Board or his designated agent, who shall make rules and regulations respecting applications therefor and issuance thereof."

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 4-75-713(a) is amended to read as follows:
- "(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration Tobacco Control Board, or any person injured by any violation or who would suffer injury from any threatened violation of this subchapter, may maintain an action in any court of equitable jurisdiction to prevent, restrain, or enjoin the violation or threatened violation."

SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1	act are declared to be severable.		
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3	SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
4	hereby repealed.		
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6	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the		
7	Eighty-second General Assembly that the Arkansas Unfair Cigarette Sales Act,		
8	4-75-701, sets minimum selling prices for wholesale and retail sales of		
9	cigarettes in Arkansas. Although the Unfair Cigarette Sales Act contains a		
10	licensing requirement for wholesalers and retailers, its main purpose is to		
11	establish fair and lawful competition in the wholesale and retail sale of		
12	cigarettes in Arkansas. Prior to the creation of the Tobacco Control Board in		
13	1997, the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration has		
14	been responsible for administering the Unfair Cigarette Sales Act. Therefore,		
15	an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for		
16	the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective		
17	on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved		
18	nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the		
19	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is		
20	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective		
21	on the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
