21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Any person who is at least 21 years of age and who was
24 adopted in the State of Arkansas is entitled to obtain from the Bureau of
25 Vital Statistics a copy of his or her original birth certificate.
26

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
