13 ENROLLED IN; FOR THE ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATH AND  
14 SCIENCE TO PAY FOR THE ADVANCE PLACEMENT EXAMS TAKEN  
15 BY THE STUDENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. (a) Students at the Arkansas School For Mathematics and  
28 Science shall take an advance placement examination for each and every advance  
29 placement class in which the student is enrolled.

30 (b) The Arkansas School For Mathematics and Science shall pay the cost  
31 of the advance placement examination for students enrolled in the school who  
32 are taking advance placement examinations.

33  
34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
