10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §26-57-904."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
17

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-57-904(a)(1) relating to the taxes levied  
19 by the Arkansas Soft Drink Tax Act is amended to read as follows:

20 "(a) There is hereby levied and there shall be collected a tax upon  
21 every distributor, manufacturer, or wholesale dealer, to be calculated as  
22 follows:

23 (1) ~~Two dollars (\$2.00)~~ One dollar and forty seven cents (\$1.47)  
24 per gallon for each gallon of soft drink syrup sold or offered for sale in the  
25 State of Arkansas:"  
26

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.  
36

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
2 hereby repealed.
