## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-35-210 TO  
AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO  
ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS FOR THE MOVEMENT OF OVERWEIGHT  
VEHICLES TRANSPORTING CROSS-TIES FROM THEIR FIRST  
POINT OF PROCESSING TO THE POINT AT WHICH THEY SHALL  
UNDERGO CREOSOTE PROCESSING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"TO AUTHORIZE THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO  
ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS FOR THE MOVEMENT  
OF CERTAIN OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-210 is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

"(k) The State Highway Commission is authorized to issue special permits at a charge of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a one (1) year permit for the movement of cross-ties from their first point of processing to the point at which they shall undergo creosote processing by five-axle vehicles registered and licensed pursuant to Arkansas Code 27-14-601(a)(3)(G)(ii) where the loaded weight on any tandem axle on such vehicles is greater than the allowable tandem axle limit of thirty-four thousand (34,000) pounds, provided the one-way mileage for such transportation trip is no greater than one hundred (100) miles, no tandem axle weight exceeds thirty-six thousand five hundred (36,500) pounds, and no portion of such trip is on any part of the federal interstate highways. The State Highway Commission shall issue no more

1 than five (5) special permits to the same person during the same calendar  
2 year. "

4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7  
8 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to  
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
11 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
12 act are declared to be severable.

14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
15 hereby repealed.
