25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. On and after the effective date of this act, all powers,
28 duties, functions, records, property and funds administered or provided by
29 other support divisions within the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
30 Department for the Traffic Safety Section of the Programs and Contracts
31 Division regarding or relating to programs pursuant to Title 23 United States
32 Code Section 402, with the exception of the Traffic Accident Record System
33 developed by that department, and which programs are administered by that
34 department pursuant to the laws of this state and transferred to that
35 department by Act 153 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989, shall be
36 transferred to the Department of Arkansas State Police.
