For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-9-108 (b)(4)(A) TO
AUTHORIZE PRIVATE OR PUBLIC CORPORATIONS,
ASSOCIATIONS, OR OTHER ENTITIES, WHETHER CHARITABLE,
NON-PROFIT OR FOR PROFIT, TO EMPLOY PERSONS TO ISSUE
CITATIONS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING VIOLATIONS
OCCURRING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO AUTHORIZE PRIVATE OR PUBLIC
CORPORATIONS, ASSOCIATIONS, OR OTHER
ENTITIES TO EMPLOY PERSONS TO ISSUE
CITATIONS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING
VIOLATIONS OCCURRING WITHIN THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-9-108(b)(4)(A) is amended, ab initio, to
read as follows:

"(4)(A) Cities of the first and second class and incorporated towns are
authorized to employ persons or to contract with private or public
corporations, associations, or other entities whether charitable, non-profit
or for profit, that employ persons who do not meet certification requirements
prescribed by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and
Training to enforce and execute any or all provisions of a municipal parking
enforcement ordinance, including but not limited to, the ~~issue~~ issuance of

2 ~~city or town~~ the collection of fines, and any other parking enforcement
3 process or procedure as may be established by ordinance of the municipality."
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5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
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15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
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18 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
19 Eighty-second General Assembly that it is essential to the effective and
20 efficient administration and enforcement of parking ordinances in
21 municipalities that such municipalities be permitted to employ enforcement
22 personnel who do not meet the certification requirements of the Arkansas
23 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards or to contract for such services by
24 noncertified enforcement personnel; that this act is designed to permit
25 municipalities to employ or contract for the services and should be given
26 effect immediately to enable municipalities to provide for the proper
27 enforcement of such ordinances. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist
28 and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
29 peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by
30 the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it
31 shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which
32 the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
33 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
34 overrides the veto.
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
