SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-51-404 is amended to read as follows: "27-51-404. Signals to stop or turn <u>or change lanes</u>.

(a) Any stop or turn signal <u>or signal for changing lanes</u> when required
in this subchapter shall be given either by means of the hand and arm or by
signal lamps, except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section.

(b) Any motor vehicle in use on a highway shall be equipped with, and the required signal shall be given by, signal lamps when the distance from the center of the top of the steering post to the left outside limit of the body, cab, or load of the motor vehicle exceeds twenty-four inches (24") or when the distance from the center of the top of the steering post to the rear limit of the body or load exceeds fourteen feet (14'). The latter measurement shall apply to any single vehicle and also to any combination of vehicles.

(c) The failure to give a turn signal as required in this section shall
 not subject the offender any fine or other criminal penalty but may be used as
 evidence in any civil action involving a traffic accident."
