20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-37-302 is amended to read as follows:		
21	"27-37-302. Windshields, etc., to be unobstructed.		
22	No person shall drive any motor vehicle with any sign, poster, or other		
23	nontransparent material upon the front windshield, sidewings, side, or rear		
24	windows of the vehicle other than a certificate or other paper required to be		
25	so displayed by law, if it obstructs the operator's view or the safe operation

28		is amended to read as follows:	
29	"27-37-304. Obstruction of interior prohibited.		
30	(a)(1)(A) It is unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle		
31	which has any substance or material, except rearview mirrors and decals		
32	required by law, attached to the windshield at any point more than four and		
33	one-half inches (41/2") above the bottom of the windshield, if the substance		
34		or material obstructs the operator's view or the safe operation of the

1	vehicle which has any substance or material attached to the window of either	
2	front door except substances or materials attached by the manufacturer, if the	
3	substance or material obstructs the operator's view or the safe operation of	
4	the vehicle.	
5	(2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to motorists	
6	driving motor vehicles registered in other states that have enacted	
7	legislation regulating the shading of windshields or windows of motor vehicles	
8	and are driving on Arkansas roads and highways.	
9	(b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the shading or tinting of	
10	windows of newly manufactured automobiles so long as the newly manufactured	
11	automobiles comply with all federal laws pertaining thereto.	
12	(c) Violation of this section shall constitute a Class C misdemeanor."

14	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature	
15	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code	
16	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.	
17		
18	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to	
19	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect	
20	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without	
21	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this	
22	act are declared to be severable.	
23		
24	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are	
25	hereby repealed.
