9	"REQUESTING THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC

25	WHEREAS, the traffic laws of Arkansas, including many of the "rules of
26	the road" for motor vehicles, are found largely throughout Title 27 of the
27	Arkansas Code of 1987, Annotated which is the codified version of Act 300 of
28	1937; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Act 300 of 1937 was based largely on the model law called the
31	"Uniform Vehicle Code: Rules of the Road" which has, since 1937, been updated
32	and there have been many changes in our society and in the conduct of motor
33	vehicle laws and in the "Rules of the Road" in the sixty-two (62) years since
34	Act 300 was originally enacted; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, the traffic laws of Arkansas are sixty-two (62) years old and

1	there have been numerous changes in motor vehicles, in the design,
2	construction and marking of highways, county roads, and city streets, in the
3	standard equipment found on automobiles, and changes in the traffic safety
4	standards since 1937; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, it would seem timely for the Arkansas General Assembly on the
7	eve of the Twenty-First ( $21^{\rm st}$ ) Century to make the considerable effort to
8	review the traffic laws of Arkansas for possible updating and revision,
9	
10	NOW THEREFORE,
11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
12	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
13	
14	That the House Interim Committee on Public Transportation and the Senate
15	Interim Committee on Transportation, Aging and Legislative Affairs are
16	requested to conduct a study of the Arkansas traffic laws and determine if
17	they need to be updated and revised to make them more uniform with the laws of
18	other states, or with model laws, and to make their recommendations in the
19	form of proposed legislation to the Eighty-Third General Assembly of Arkansas
20	in January, 2001.
