23 NOW THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

27 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education are requested to
28 conduct a study of the impact of deregulation of the utility industry on the
29 funding and operation of public schools in Arkansas prior to the convening of
30 the next regular session of the General Assembly. The committees will work
31 closely with the House and Senate Interim Committees on Insurance and Commerce
32 in their study.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House and Senate Interim Committees on
35 Education shall report to the Legislative Council the results of this study by
36 no later than October 1, 2000.
