30 WHEREAS, Senator Dale Bumpers has ably served his state as our United
31 States Senator, as our Governor, as an honorable practicing member of the
32 Arkansas bar, as a small businessman, as a United States Marine during World
33 War II, and as a loving son, husband, and father; and

35 WHEREAS, Senator Bumpers, before he entered statewide politics in 1970,
36 lived in his hometown of Charleston, growing up, attending college at the

1 University of Arkansas and receiving his law degree from Northwestern
2 University, serving his community as city attorney, school board president,
3 and president of the Chamber of Commerce; and

5 WHEREAS, Dale Bumpers is married to the former Betty Flanagan of
6 Charleston, and they are the parents of three children, Brent, Bill, and
7 Brooke, and the grandparents of five; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Betty Bumpers has taken the lead nationally and
10 internationally in childhood immunization efforts and as founder of Peace
11 Links; and

13 WHEREAS, Dale Bumpers, after becoming Governor of Arkansas in 1971,
14 reorganized state government to significantly improve efficiency and
15 management; and

17 WHEREAS, Dale Bumpers, as our Arkansas Senator for 24 years kept in
18 close touch with the people of Arkansas, making more than 100 appearances
19 annually while maintaining his work in Washington; and

21 WHEREAS, Senator Bumpers made all Arkansans proud by his stature in the
22 United States Senate as a champion for a balanced budget, a foe to boondoggles
23 such as the Supercollider, a protector of public lands and the national
24 treasures that they contain, a friend to family farmers, and a proponent of
25 rural development; and

27 WHEREAS, Senator Bumpers by his intellect, leadership, and
28 determination, set a standard in his Senate service that Senators from
29 throughout the United States sought to live up to; and

31 WHEREAS, Senator Bumpers continues his leadership, as he worked for the
32 success of the Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food, and Life Sciences
33 at the University of Arkansas and as he works with our next generation of
34 leaders as Distinguished Professor of Policy at U of A; and

36 WHEREAS, Senator Bumpers has set a standard for friendship to his

1 Franklin County neighbors, his fellow Arkansans including the President and
2 Mrs. Clinton, his colleagues in Congress;
