9 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

10 "TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF
11 THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,
12 APRIL 30, 1999; TO PROVIDE FOR RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-
13 SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON
14 APRIL 10, 1999 OR AT SUCH EARLIER TIME AS MAY BE
15 AGREED UPON BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
16 REPRESENTATIVES; TO AUTHORIZE THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE
17 OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF
18 THE SENATE BY JOINT PROCLAMATION TO RECONVENE THE
19 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON APRIL
20 30, 1999 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,
21 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, TO CONSIDER THE NEED
22 FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE
23 EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY, OR TO ADJOURN THE
24 EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT
25 DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO
26 RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS
27 NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON APRIL
28 30, 1999, THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND
29 GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE. "

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

(1) The regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is hereby extended until 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999.

(2) The regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business on April 10, 1999, or at such earlier time as may be agreed upon by the House of Representatives and Senate.

(3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation, reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999, for the purpose of considering executive vetoes, correcting errors and oversights, and considering the need for further extension of the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly, or may adjourn the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly at any time before that date if they determine it is not necessary to reconvene. If the General Assembly is not reconvened before 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999, the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly is hereby adjourned sine die on that date.
