BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- (1) The regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is hereby extended until 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999.
- (2) The regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business on April 10, 1999, or at such earlier time as may be agreed upon by the House of Representatives and Senate.
- (3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation, reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999, for the purpose of considering executive vetoes, correcting errors and oversights, and considering the need for further extension of the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly, or may adjourn the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly at any time before that date if they determine it is not necessary to reconvene. If the General Assembly is not reconvened before 12:00 noon, April 30, 1999, the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly is hereby adjourned sine die on that date.
