## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES OF THE EI GHTY- SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJ ORI TY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEI NG THERETO:

That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the el ectors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general el ection for Representatives and Senators, if a maj ority of the el ectors voting thereon at such el ection, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. Section 16 of Article 16 of the Arkansas Constitution is amended to read as follows:
"§ 16. Providing for exemption of val ue of residence of person 65-or over occupi ed by its owner.

The General Assenbly, upon approval thereof by a vote of not less than threefourths (3/4ths) a maj ority of the members el ected to each house, may provi de that the val uation of real property actually occupi ed by its owner as a residence is sixty-five (65) years of age, or older, may be exempt in such amount as may be determined by Iaw, but no greater than the first Twenty

Thousand Dollars ( $\$ 20,000$ ) in value thereof, as a homestead fromad val orem property taxes. [Added by Const. Amend. 59.]"
