24	that numerous health hazards are associated with smoking; and
25	
26	Whereas, various nationally-recognized scientific and health
27	organizations have concluded that passive smoking, or involuntary exposure to
28	tobacco smoke is a significant health hazard as well; and

30	Whereas, smoking is offensive to many members of the House of
31	Representatives; and

33	Whereas, the health and well-being of the members of the Arkansas House
34	of Representatives should be of the utmost importance to smokers and non-
35	smokers alike; and
