22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
23 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 That every agency of this state which has direct contact with parents of
26 young children is requested and encouraged to make efforts to educate parents
27 as to the risk of harm to children left alone in motor vehicles.

28
29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each agency is encouraged to utilize every
30 avenue including public service announcements and participation in public
31 gatherings to inform parents of the risk of harm to young children left
32 unattended in motor vehicles and the penalties for leaving children unattended
33 in motor vehicles.

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas Department of Health is
36 requested to coordinate the efforts of the various state agencies to comply

1 with the requests and intent of this resolution.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this resolution a copy
4 hereof be transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House to the Director of the
5 Department of Health and that the Department of Health identify the various
6 agencies within the purview of this resolution and provide a copy of this
7 resolution to those agencies.
