28 Third Street and Cumberland in Little Rock, and later moved to what is now the
29 State Capitol, and finally to its current location at 2400 West Markham in
30 Little Rock; and

32 WHEREAS, the staff at the Arkansas School for the Deaf have diligently
33 and faithfully discharged their duties in providing a quality education to the
34 deaf and hard-of-hearing students in the State of Arkansas; and

36 WHEREAS, the Arkansas School for the Deaf has become one of the national
