## NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES OF THE EI GHTY- SECOND GENERAL

 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:THAT the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is requested to conduct a study to determine the age at which unborn babies begin to feel pain; and the amount of pain inflicted on unborn babies by each abortion method used in Arkansas. The University of Arkansas for Medi cal Sci ences should report its findings to the Governor and the Legislative Council not I ater than January 1, 2000 and provi de a copy of the report to each member of the House of Representatives. For the purpose of the study requested by this resol ut i on:
(1) "Abortion methods" means medical procedures used to term nate pregnancies incl uding dilation and evacuation, suction curettage, dilation and extraction with labor induction, hysterectom, saline, and suction aspiration;
(2) "Pai n" means an unpl easant sensory or emotional experience or both associated with actual or potential tissue damage or described internฐ of actual or potential tissue damage, incl uding the location, quality, radi ation, frequency and triggering agents of an unpleasant sensory or emotional experience or both associated with actual or potential tissue damage; and
(3) "Unborn babies" means fetuses in utero fromthe time of conception to birth.
